COMMENTS:

Metro ROW Project Area: Consultation with the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) is required prior to the issuance of any building permit for projects within 100 feet of Metro-owned Rail or Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) right-of-way (ROW) that meet the below criteria. Metro must review applicable projects to ensure safe access to, and operations of, transportation services and facilities.

INSTRUCTIONS:

To begin Metro review and consultation for projects meeting the criteria listed below, applicants shall submit project information via the Application In-Take form at https://www.metro.net/devreview/.

Projects that require Metro clearance include:

- Demolition
- Excavation
- New structures
- Improvements or additions to existing structures
- Seismic retrofitting

- Tunneling / Boring
- Construction or maintenance that requires use of cranes
- Truck delivery of concrete and other materials
- Freestanding sign structures

Projects that clearly pose no impact to Metro's transit facilities or operations and do not require Metro's review include:

- Tenant Improvement projects: Projects where the work is completely contained inside the building or structure, including, but not limited to work such as remodeling, partitioning, and satellite installations.
- Change of use.
- Use of Land: Projects which involve no construction activities.
- Non-freestanding signs (e.g., wall signs, projecting signs, etc.).

Clearance Process Notes:

- 1. All initial submittals must be sent through the In-Take Form. Metro will not review <u>incomplete</u> submittals.
- 2. Metro encourages Applicants to coordinate with Metro early in the planning process to ensure compatatibility between proposed projects and Metro facilities.

- 3. Applicant will receive a confirmation upon submittal of the In-Take Form.
- 4. Depending on the nature of the project's adjacency to Metro ROW, Metro may request additional information for review, assess plan check fees, and/or schedule coordination meetings as part of due diligence prior to clearance.
- 5. Once a project has been cleared, Metro staff will update the City Plan Check and Information System (PCIS) to reflect Metro's clearance.
- 6. There shall be <u>no</u> in-person or by-phone clearance.
